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#### BANKRUPTCY WORKSHEET

The law allows you to keep some money and most types of necessary property in bankruptcy. To receive this protection, you must list all information requested by the following questions. <u>If you do not list an asset, that asset may not be protected in bankruptcy</u>. If you leave out one of your creditors, you may have to pay the money to that creditor or you may even lose your right to bankruptcy. It may also be considered a crime if you intentionally give false information or leave out information. If you have any questions about whether you should list certain property or a debt, please write it down and ask me.

#### Things to keep in mind when answering these questions:

- 1. Please make sure to fill out every question on every page. If something doesn't apply, say so.
- 2. Whenever the name of a person of firm is asked for, give the **full name and address**. Remember that discharge of a debt depends on whether we properly notify your creditors of your bankruptcy.
- 3. If you do not know the exact amount that you owe, give an estimate.
- 4. List every creditor and everyone that has had anything to do with your debts, including cosigners. If a bill you owe has been sent to a collection agency or an attorney, make sure to list both (or provide copies bills from both) of the person you owe and the collection agency or attorney, giving the full address of each.
- 5. I recommend that you get a current copy of your credit reports from all 3 credit reporting bureaus to make sure that you are aware of every person and/or company who claims to be a creditor. If there is a creditor you don't know about or have forgotten about, that debt may not be discharged if you don't list it. If you prefer, I can get copies of your credit reports for approximately \$50 (the fees vary). Tell me if you want to do this.
- 6. If you own real property (land or a building), I recommend that you record a homestead exemption before your bankruptcy is filed.

7. If you have not already done so, please make sure to provide me with the following:

- (a) Tax returns for the last year
- (b) Paycheck stubs for the last 60 days.
